You will have to register and pre-pay the main events, since NMAA has signed contracts and most services re food and preparation must be ordered and paid for up to 10 days in advance of the Event. Watch those deadlines. The Thursday Events are optional, and you will now pay at the door.

You will have been given a Room Discount at our Hotel (Marriott Inn - Riverside) around \$100 off room rates. Staying there for the out-of-towners is a convenience due to the Saturday Night Banquet.

You will receive a Reunion Packet ("Individual Trip Kit") at the time of Reunion Check-in. It includes Schedules, current NMAA Fact Sheets, your paid Event Tickets, and usually includes a "Reunion Memorabilia Souvenir Item".

You will have further opportunities to support NMAA (Norton-March Alumni Association) that puts on these events by officially joining or renewing your membership, and purchase additional Memorabilia Items that financially supports us, so bring your check book (ATM is on-site at the Marriott).

You will see that in last ten years, Reunions went from some **30 to over 170 Veterans** who attended and over **125 that attended** in 2017 alone:

- 75 or (45%) live in California but outside the RIV/SBD (Inland Empire) area.
- 35 or (20%) live in the RIV/SBD (Inland Empire) area.
- Some are still working or are still working or serving at March ARB.
